

# Spring Cleaning Garden Checklist



- Clean out the garden. Rake out all old mulch, leaves & debris that accumulated over winter
- Weed. Be sure to remove roots fully. Lay contractor grade weed fabric to prevent regrowth
- Revitalize the soil. Your soil is likely dried out & packed after winter, it's time to add moisture. Try adding some organic compost or super loam.
- Divide perennials. Trim back any sticky plants, like sedum or Hydrangea to get them ready for this season's flowers.
- Add mulch. 3" mulch helps prevent weeds & diseases from invading your garden. Not sure how much you need? Typically 1 yard of mulch covers 100 square feet when laid 3" deep.
